



2023 MINISTRY HIGHLIGHTS

- Major Legislative priorities passed during the 2023 legislative session
 - Do No Harm Act - banning gender “transitions” of children (SB 150)
 - Parental Rights Protection Act - banning LGBTQ indoctrination K-12 (SB 150)
 - Student Privacy Act - protections in bathrooms, locker rooms (SB 150)
 - Religious Freedom Protection for Teachers (HB 547)
- Important legal victories, TFF joins powerful legal briefs in important cases
 - Planned Parenthood’s state challenge to Kentucky Human Life Protection Act dropped
 - U.S. Sixth Circuit upheld Kentucky’s ban on child gender “transitions” included in SB 150
 - Religious freedom & free speech victory at U.S. Supreme Court in *303 Media*
- Thousands of lives saved in the year since *Roe* was overturned and Kentucky’s Human Life Protection Act went into full effect
- Expanded our Church outreach efforts through a new initiative called the Church Ambassador Network that builds relationships between Pastors and elected leaders
- TFF Advocacy Center grows with more than 73,000 messages sent to elected officials
- Our first-ever Kentucky Family Forum was a great success, with an inspiring day of important discussions on public policy issues from a Biblical worldview from 20+ speakers
- Hosted Faith & Advocacy Day and rally for SB 150 veto override at the Kentucky Capitol, and TFF team had 40+ speaking engagements in last 12 months
- Awarded State Policy Ally of the Year by Alliance Defending Freedom, the nation’s largest Christian legal organization
