PRO-LIFE: UPHOLDING DIGNITY, SUPPORTING WOMEN, AND CREATING A CULTURE OF LIFE

- Pro-Life Assistance for Women & Families (HB 380 Rep. Nancy Tate)
 - Exempts diapers, wipes, bottles, and breast pumps from sales tax.
 - Establishes tax credits for donations to pregnancy resource centers and for adoption services.
 - · Makes grants available to assist pro-life pregnancy resource centers with startup or expansion costs.
- Confronting Rape: Increased Penalties for Perpetrators & Pro-Life Assistance for Victims (Bill #s Forthcoming)
 - Rape is one of the most egregious attacks possible upon the inherent human dignity of someone created in the image of God, and perpetrators deserve to be punished accordingly.
 - Kentucky must support the healing process for victims of rape by upholding the human dignity of all, providing compassionate assistance, and increasing access to the physical & mental care they need.

PROTECTING CHILDREN

- Age Verification for Porn Websites (HB 241 Rep. Shane Baker)
 - Protecting children from the exposure of pornography, which is especially harmful at young ages, by requiring age verification on pornography websites.
- Age Verification for Social Media (HB 450 Rep. Nick Wilson)
 - Children should not be able to access social media without parental consent, with its addictive nature and numerous potential negative impacts.
- Material Harmful to Children in Schools (HB 191 Rep. Josh Calloway)
 - If any material is too sexually graphic to be recited during a school board meeting, then it must be immediately removed from schools within the district.
- Protections Against Sexually Explicit Performances (SB 147 Sen. Lindsey Tichenor/HB 402 Rep. Nancy Tate)

RELIGIOUS LIBERTY AND CONSCIENCE RIGHTS

- Exempt Churches & Other 501(c)(3) Organizations from Sales & Use Tax (HB 442 Rep. James Tipton)
 - Recent legislative changes force churches with sports outreach ministries to register with the state and become tax collectors, which is a burden to their religious and charitable mission.
- Healthcare Heroes Recruitment and Retention Act (HB 49 Rep. Steve Rawlings)
 - Medical professionals should have the freedom to provide medical care to all in a manner consistent with their conscience. Doctors and healthcare workers should be allowed to live out their oath to "do no harm."
- Religious Freedom Restoration Act [RFRA] (HB 47 Rep. Steve Rawlings)
 - Kentucky's Religious Freedom Restoration Act is in need of a few updates and definitions to ensure that it continues to adequately protect the religious liberty rights of every Kentuckian.

ADDITIONAL PRO-FAMILY BILLS

- Kentucky Women's Bill of Rights (HB 390 Rep. David Hale)
 - In order to ensure that the dignity and rights of women are honored throughout the Commonwealth, this bill (1) prevents the redefinition of what a woman is, (2) ensures fair treatment, and (3) permits separation of the sexes if done in the interest of maintaining safety, privacy, and fairness.
- Improvements to Medical Marijuana Program (Bill # Forthcoming)
- Addressing Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion [DEI] Programs (HB 9 Rep. Jennifer Decker/SB 6 Sen. Mike Wilson/SB 93 Sen. Stephen Meredith)
