### **METHODOLOGY:**

Scores are calculated based on votes, including any vote clarifications recorded, and sponsoring priority legislation. Votes are valued at 10 pts, bill sponsorships at 2.5 pts, and priority bill author bonuses at 5 pts. Penalty for anti-family bill/amendment sponsors are valued between 2.5 – 10 pts. Not voting or voting present is \*generally\* scored negatively.
