2025 MINISTRY HIGHLIGHTS

- Important legislative victories during the 2025 legislative session
 - Protected Taxpayer-Dollars ban on taxpayer-funded gender "transitions" for prisoners and those on Medicaid (SB 2/HB 495)
 - Reversed Beshear's Attack on Christian Counseling overturned so-called "conversion therapy" executive order (HB 495)
 - Restored Ten Commandments Monument to KY Capitol Coach Kennedy's SCOTUS win opened the door for this (HJR 15)
 - Protected Kids in Schools ban on cellphones in schools during class time and prohibition on school employees communicating with kids without parental knowledge (HB 208/SB 181)
 - Strengthened Pro-Life Laws clarified language to ensure women receive proper medical care,
 legalized freestanding birthing centers (HB 90), and defeated every attempt to weaken pro-life laws
- Important legal victories and cases, TFF joins legal briefs in four Supreme Court victories
 - SCOTUS upholds ban on gender "transitions" for kids & age verification laws protecting kids from pornography
 - SCOTUS protects ability of parents to opt-out of LGBT public school curriculums
 - SCOTUS opens the door for states to defund Planned Parenthood
 - Pro-abortion ACLU challenge to Kentucky's pro-life laws dismissed
- Equipped thousands of Christians and pastors through our education & ministry events, publications, and speaking engagements. The 2025 KY Family Forum was our largest yet and featured Coach Joe Kennedy
- TFF Advocacy Center sees more than 60,000 messages sent to elected officials over last year
- Spoke truth in numerous local, state, and national media outlets like *Kentucky's Voice, Kentucky Today, Kentucky Tonight, King of Kings Radio Network, American Family Radio, Washington Stand,* and the *New York Times*
- TFF team hosted and/or spoke at over 40 events and churches across Kentucky
